Dallas County VOAD Mission and Guiding Principles

MISSION

The mission of Dallas County VOAD is to foster efficient, streamlined service delivery to people affected by disaster, while eliminating unnecessary duplication of services and effort, through cooperation in the four phases of disaster: preparedness, response, recovery and mitigation.

Dallas County VOAD integrates its mission and guiding principles with local government emergency management through this collaborative effort.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

This mission and our structure ensures Dallas County VOAD supports the National VOAD guiding principles of the “4 C’s”;

Cooperation. Communication, Coordination and Collaboration. Furthermore, Dallas County VOAD fully supports the National VOAD Mission Statement and share the same tenets. The National VOAD signature logo means “Uniqueness of diversity funneled into a cooperative goal”.

Dallas County VOAD is not a government agency nor is it a direct affiliate of the government agencies of Dallas County.

The Dallas County VOAD is not designed for operational management, and is not itself a service delivery organization. Instead, its members operate in a collaborative nature to provide disaster relief and recovery services, and do so cooperatively through the Dallas County VOAD.

Membership Information

Dallas County VOAD is structured with two membership categories: Partner or Associate.

Partner— Organizations meeting all of the following criteria, are eligible for the Partner category of membership in Dallas County VOAD.

1. Organizations with voluntary memberships and constituencies which are not-for-profit; that is, those qualified under the IRS Code as 501c3.
2. Organizations must have a disaster response program and policy for commitment of resources to meet the needs of people affected by disaster without discrimination
3. Organizations must be county-wide in scope.

Associate—The Associate category of membership may be granted to organizations, government agencies, or businesses with disaster planning and operations responsibilities or capabilities that do not meet all of the criteria for Partner membership and:

1. Have a disaster response program and policy for commitment of resources to meet the needs of people affected by disaster without discrimination.
2. Need not be county-wide in scope.

To request membership, please submit an official organization letter of intent on letterhead to our Membership Committee Chair along with our completed Member Application.

Conditions of Membership

1. Meet the membership criteria of the Dallas County VOAD. See Dallas County VOAD Bylaws.
2. Agree with the mission of the Dallas County VOAD.
3. Have an authorized representative at Dallas County VOAD business and special meetings.

New Members: New members joining Dallas County VOAD will be added to the next publication of the Member and Resource Directory.

Organizations with interest in joining Dallas County VOAD , must complete a new member information form, letter of membership request on official organization letterhead and submit the completed documents to the Membership Committee Chair for membership consideration. All new prospective members must be recommended for membership by the Membership Committee to the attending Partner Members at a general business meeting. Contact the Membership Committee Chairperson.

Publishing Schedule: The Dallas County VOAD Member and Resource Directory is published and distributed to its membership and emergency management partners once per year.
